NSU & Scholars' Students Give Back

After the disaster caused by Hurricane Harvey, a team of 27 Northwestern State and Scholars' College students coordinated by Dr. Curt Phifer set out to help victims of flooding in Beaumont and Port Arthur, Texas. The team worked with non-profit organization Operation Blessing, which organized the flood relief work for the volunteer groups.

"I have been able to participate in disaster-relief efforts numerous times, ranging from tornadoes... to hurricanes and flooding... to the earthquake in Haiti," Dr. Phifer said. "Every time I go, the gratitude

An emergency grant given by the Northwestern State Student Government Association and NSU President Dr. Chris Maggio helped cover expenses such as food, supplies, and transportation. Housing was provided by Operation Blessing.

- Saturday night dinner and dance at the beautiful Natchitoches Events Center

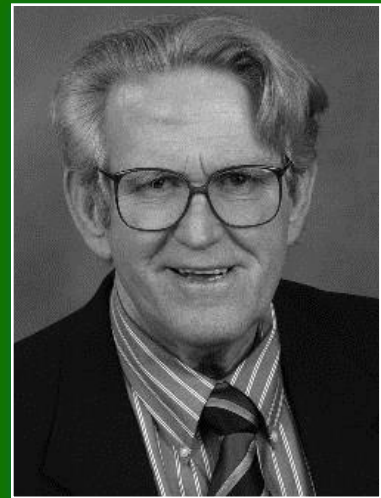
