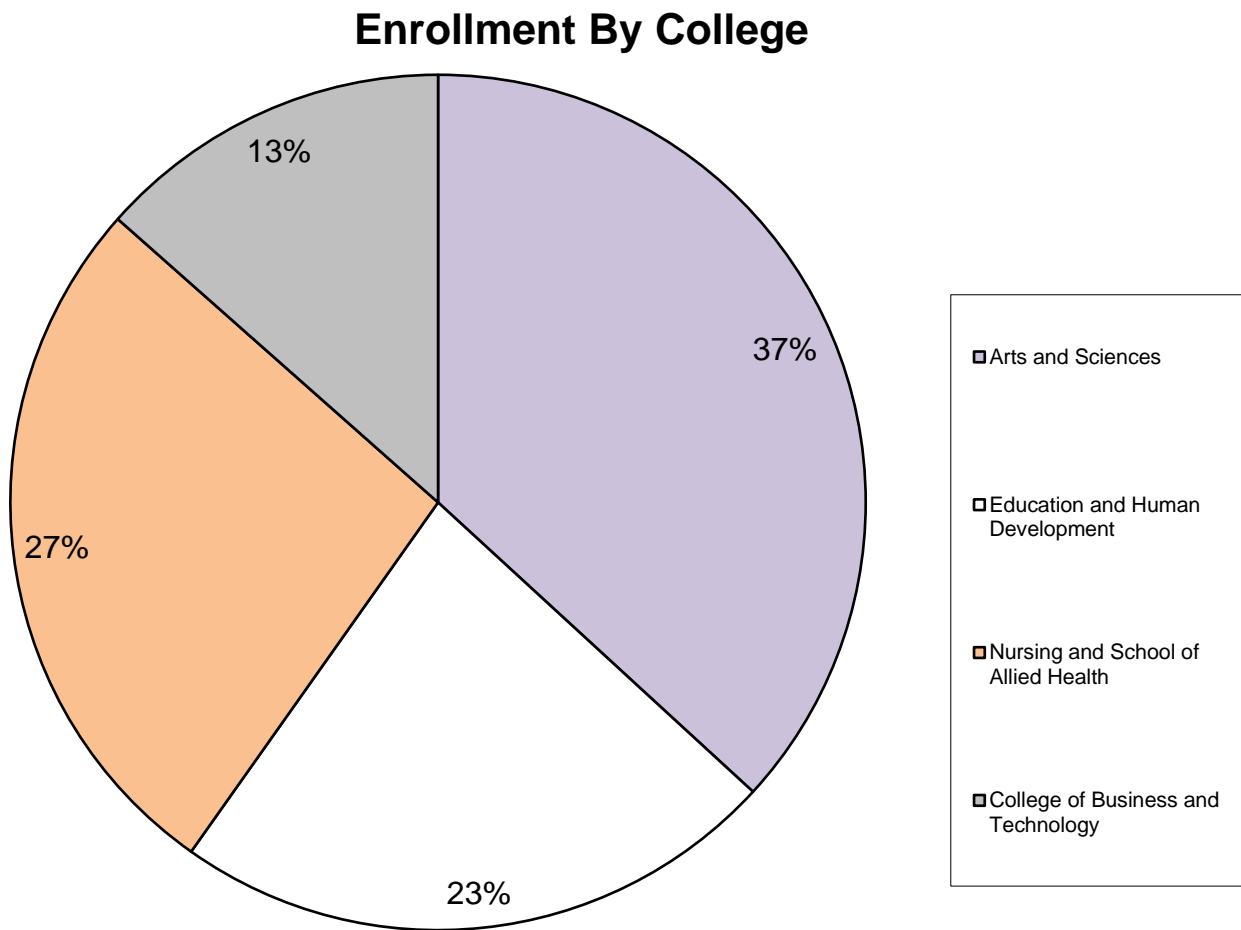

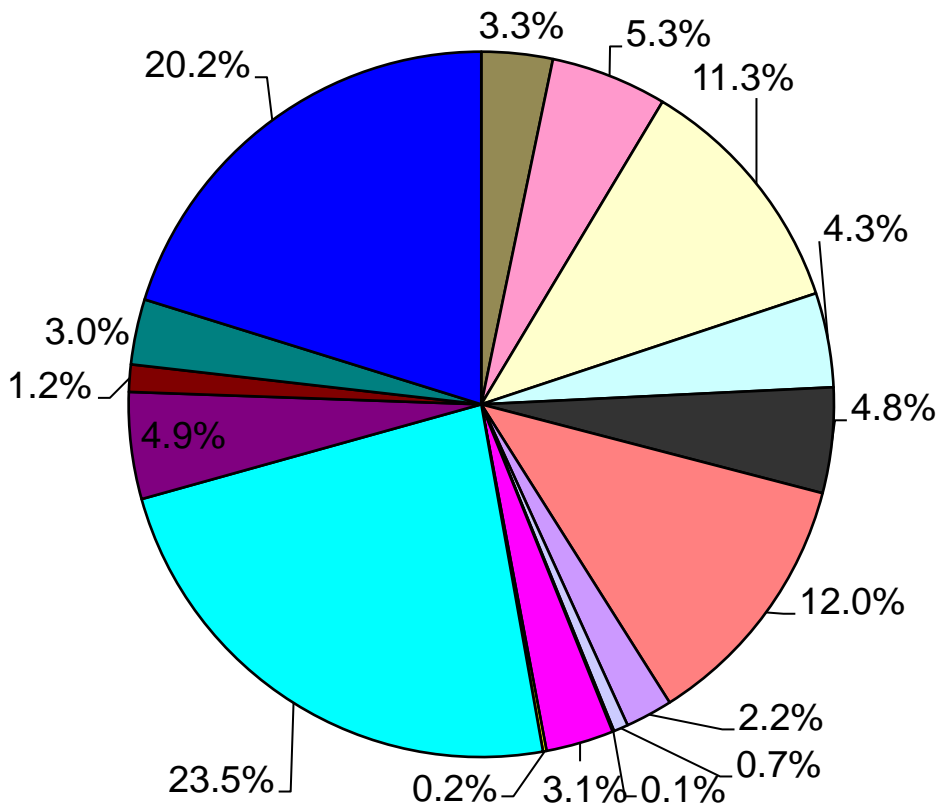

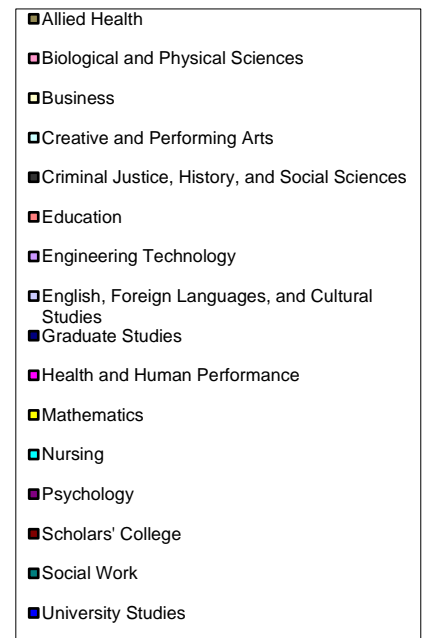

NSU's Office of Sponsored Programs is dedicated to providing state-of-the-art information, advice, and assistance to faculty and staff relative to all sponsored-programs matters/issues and continuously seeks ways to improve the processes and services it provides. The University encourages its faculty to undertake sponsored, scholarly activities as a means of (a) offering modern instructional programs to students and (b) enhancing the academic stature of the faculty and the University.

Department of Military Science US Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC)

With an agreement signed between Northwestern State College and United States Department of the Army, an anti-aircraft field artillery unit of the Reserve Officers' Training Corps was established in the fall of 1950. That August, NSC authorized a building to house the ROTC unit.

Under President Prather, the new military science program enrolled its first students in the fall of 1950 with one officer and five enlisted men on the staff. By the end of the 1950-51 academic year, 220 men had selected military training and the future of the program looked promising. In 1965, NSC under President Kyser signed an agreement with the Department of Army stating that the Military Science Senior ROTC Program would be provided with a university secretary, armory, and utilities. The ROTC building was later named Gov. James A. Noe Armory.

NSU's Department of Military Science and the Joint Readiness Training Center at Fort Polk, Louisiana, mutually support US Army Cadet Command by identifying quality Soldiers with officer potential and assisting them in transition from the enlisted ranks to officers under the Army's ROTC Green to Gold Program.

The NSU ROTC Demon Battalion has commissioned over 1,000 Second Lieutenants into the United States armed services, whether on active duty, Army Reserve, or Louisiana Army National Guard. Many graduates have become distinguished Army officers, including eight general officers.

An alumni arm of the Demon Battalion was formed in 2007, and it was officially recognized by President Randall Webb as the Northwestern Demon Regiment. The Demon Regiment currently hosts the Hall of Fame, which was begun in 1983. Portraits and biographies of the Hall of Fame honorees are on permanent display in Noe Armory.

Notably, five NSU ROTC commissioned officers have been inducted into NSU's highest Hall of Distinction, the Long Purple Line.
