I. DEPARTMENT OF ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY

A. Make the following course changes:

- EET 1300 – change course description and prerequisite.
- EET 1301 – add course description
- EET 1320 – change course prerequisite.
- IET 3740 – change course title, change course description, add prerequisite.

B. Make the following changes to the Electronics Engineering Technology (141) program:

- Major Requirements: Correct total semester hours required to (66-69).
- Biomedical (141B) concentration: Change required hours for BMET 4950 to 4 hours (increasing total semester hours required for the concentration to 23).

II. LOUISIANA SCHOLARS' COLLEGE

A. Make the following changes to the Electronics Engineering Technology Joint Major (843) program:

- Major Requirements: Correct total semester hours required to (66-69); change the concentration total hours required to (20-23).
- Biomedical (141B) concentration: Change required hours for BMET 4950 to 4 hours (increasing total semester hours required for the concentration to 23).

B. Delete the description of the LSC Honors Certificate for students completing the BSN, which is currently published under the Traditional Majors subheading (Page 52 of the current 2020-21 University Catalog), and replace with the following as a separate subsection:

BSN in Nursing with Louisiana Scholars' Honors Certificate

Students wishing to complete the Bachelor of Science in Nursing may earn an honors certificate from the Louisiana Scholars' College by using specific Scholars' College courses to replace requirements in the traditional Nursing major. Nursing students are not required to complete the Scholars' common curriculum in its entirety, the Louisiana Scholars' College capstone course, or a thesis. Detailed requirements are given in the curriculum listed with the joint majors.

III. COLLEGE OF NURSING

- A. Make the following course change:
- NURG 5810 – delete prerequisite.
- B. Change the Master of Science in Nursing (546) curriculum pattern to include NURG 5960 in the spring semester (effective spring 2021).
