


NSU Wireless Internet Setup (Chrome OS)

Your wireless network card must be able to support WPA2 (Wi-Fi Protected Access) security to connect to the NSU network.

Step #1: If you have never setup an NSU wireless network on your computer before, please skip to **Step #4**.


Click on the **Taskbar Option** section at the bottom right corner of the screen.

Then, click **Gear** icon at the bottom right of the list.



Step #2: Click the **Wi-Fi** section in the list.




Step #4: Click on the **Taskbar Option** section at the bottom right corner of the screen.

Then, click **Gear** icon at the bottom right of the list.




Step #5: Click the **Wi-Fi** section in the list.
